ANIMAL RECOVERY MISSION TAKES FLIGHT ACROSS THE COUNTRY TO AID IN RESCUE EFFORTS OF ANIMALS CAUGHT IN CALIFORNIA WILDFIRES

Miami, FL - November 13, 2018 - Animal Recovery Mission (ARM), a vanguard animal welfare organization, after recently launching their Disaster Response Team, are currently en route to California to assist in the rescue of the hundreds of animals impacted by the raging fires. The fires are the deadliest wildfires in the state's history with 44 confirmed human deaths. The number of farmed animals, wildlife, and pets that have suffered and ultimately perished far exceed that number. Charred remains of innocent animals which attempted to escape the imminent flames are seen all too frequently. Animals are displaced, tethered to fences, and even tied to lifeguard towers at the beach in hopes they will be spared.

Partnered organizations in California are now home to several rescued animals from ARM's raids at illegal slaughter farms in Miami. These animals along with the countless others prompted ARM to take action.

"ARM's Disaster Response Team are going into the heart of the fire zones to aid and rescue suffering animals caught by the fires. We will assist wherever necessary and are hopeful for a successful outcome."

The Animal Recovery Mission is a Non-Profit animal cruelty investigative organization based in Miami Beach, Florida. A defending force for the welfare of all animals, ARM is the vanguard in eliminating extreme animal cruelty operations worldwide.
