## OPERATION FAIRLIFE ARIZONA - RAINBOW VALLEY DAIRY -

Extreme Animal Abuse Under the Coca-Cola Fairlife Brand Corporation



### SUMMARY OF INVESTIGATION



The Animal Recovery Mission (ARM) has uncovered severe violations of animal welfare laws at Rainbow Valley Dairy, a key supplier for Coca-Cola's fairlife milk brand. As part of a two-part undercover investigation, systemic cruelty to animals, gross negligence by managers, owners, and employees, and environmental violations were documented, directly implicating fairlife and Coca-Cola for failing to uphold their animal welfare policies.

In July of 2024, an undercover ARM operative was hired by Rainbow Valley Dairy, working in a general labor position for three months and was able to record video daily for two and a half months. The operative's primary responsibilities included nighttime waste management and operating machinery. While the role limited direct involvement with dairy operations, the investigator covertly recorded widespread abuse and neglect during the three-month investigation. Key evidence was collected in birthing areas, milking parlors, calf housing units, and disposal fields, providing a comprehensive view of the facility's operations.

ARM demands immediate action to hold responsible parties accountable and ensure systemic reform in the dairy supply chain.

### **Background**

Rainbow Valley Dairy is located in Buckeye, Arizona, approximately 20 minutes from Coca-Cola's fairlife plant in Goodyear, AZ. The dairy is part of the Dairymen of Arizona

Cooperative, which supplies raw milk to the fairlife facility for processing and global distribution. The DeJong family, a prominent name in the U.S. dairy industry with operations in multiple states, owns the facility. The DeJong family has a long history of supplying milk to fairlife and other major dairy brands.

ARM has previously documented abuses at DeJong-owned dairies during the 2019 Operation Fair Oaks Farms, making this a recurring pattern of systemic cruelty within their operations. Despite past exposure and promises of reform, the findings at Rainbow Valley Dairy show continued disregard for animal welfare and ethical practices.

A disturbing pattern of criminal activity, animal cruelty, and environmental degradation was documented and detailed below. As such, ARM is calling for immediate actions:

### 1. Criminal Prosecution:

- Immediate arrests and prosecution of Rainbow Valley Dairy's owners, managers, and employees responsible for documented acts of cruelty.
- Legal action against Coca-Cola and fairlife executives for complicity in enabling systemic abuse through inadequate enforcement of animal welfare policies.
- 2. **Permanent Closure:** The Arizona Department of Agriculture, USDA, and FDA should revoke Rainbow Valley Dairy's license and permanently shut down its operations to prevent further violations.
- 3. Environmental Accountability: Federal, state, and local agencies should investigate and address environmental violations to mitigate harm to the local ecosystem and public health.

### 4. Policy Overhaul:

- Coca-Cola and fairlife must reassess their animal welfare policies, implement stricter enforcement measures, and increase transparency in their supply chain.
- Partner organizations should be required to undergo regular, independent audits conducted by third-party experts to ensure compliance with humane practices.

Evidence of animal cruelty, environmental degradation, and criminal activity were witnessed and documented throughout the length of the investigation.

### **Animal Cruelty**

### 1. Poor Treatment of Calves

• Newborn calves are **violently dragged** away from their mothers, seconds after birth, using chains, ropes, and straps that caused dislocations and fractures. In several cases, the calves' legs and necks were broken during the process, leaving them to suffer without veterinary intervention.

- Workers frequently punched, kicked, whipped, and slammed calves onto concrete surfaces, often out of frustration or for expediency. These acts caused severe internal injuries, including broken ribs and possible punctured lungs.
- Calves are deprived of essential nutrition for prolonged periods, leading to malnutrition and weakened immune systems. When they were fed, workers employed oversized feeding tubes that caused internal trauma and, in some cases, fatalities.
- Male calves are being loaded onto transport vehicles in cruel and unsafe conditions, destined for resale and slaughter. Female calves are confined to 3x5 wooden crates with no room to move, stretch, or lie down comfortably. These enclosures led to chronic injuries, including bed sores, infections, broken bones, and muscle atrophy.

### 2. Poor Treatment of Dairy Cows

- Pregnant cows, unable to stand due to exhaustion or injury, are being dragged by machinery, hoisted with cables, or beaten with steel rods to force compliance. These actions resulted in broken bones, strangulation, and even death in several instances.
- Sick and injured cows are being left untreated for extended periods, leading
  to prolonged suffering and preventable deaths. Many were visibly emaciated,
  with open wounds infested with flies and other bugs.
- Workers routinely abused cows during milking procedures, including breaking tails, shocking them with electric prods, whipping, kicking punching, and stabbing them with sharp objects to elicit compliance.
- In some instances, cows were illegally killed by being shot in the neck with improperly calibrated firearms, causing prolonged suffering before death.

### 3. Overarching Neglect:

- **Extreme heat exposure**, with temperatures exceeding 135°F, caused heat stress, dehydration, and death among both cows and calves. The facility lacks adequate shade, ventilation, or access to clean water in certain area's.
- Unsanitary housing conditions contributed to the spread of possible diseases such as mastitis, respiratory infections, and sepsis. Calves and cows are often housed in dilapidated barns with hazardous flooring and exposed nails.
- Workers failed to monitor or address injuries, infections, and illnesses, allowing minor conditions to escalate and become life-threatening.

### **Environmental Violations**

### 1. Illegal Waste Disposal:

 Large quantities of liquid animal waste were discharged directly into nearby wildlife areas without proper containment, contaminating,

- groundwater and nearby rivers. This pollution poses significant risks to both the environment and public health.
- The carcasses of cows and calves were disposed of illegally on and near adjacent recreational lands, where scavengers such as vultures and coyotes fed on the remains. This practice risks spreading infectious diseases, including zoonotic illnesses like H5N1.
- 2. Zoning and Building Code Violations: Structures on the property failed to meet basic safety standards, with poorly maintained barns, leaking waste pits, and unstable storage areas. These conditions endangered both animals and workers.

### Substance Abuse

Employees were frequently observed consuming alcohol and using illicit drugs, including cocaine, during working hours while driving on public roads. This behavior further compromised the safety of animals and operations at the facility and the general public.

### **Broader Implications**

The DeJong family, who also owns dairies in Indiana, California, Texas, and other states and has long-standing ties to fairlife and Fair Oaks Farms. ARM first investigated animal cruelty at dairies owned by the DeJong family as part of Operation Fair Oaks Farms in 2019, during which footage of abuse went viral and caused global calls for industry-wide reform within the dairy industry.

Despite Coca-Cola's \$40 million investment in animal welfare reforms, including video monitoring, unannounced audits, and employee training, the investigation reveals the failure of these measures to prevent widespread abuse. Fairlife's public commitments to sourcing cruelty-free milk are contradicted by these findings, raising serious ethical and legal concerns about its supply chain oversight.

ARM remains committed to exposing systemic cruelty and advocating for the voiceless animals suffering in the dairy industry.





#### States' Farm Animal Welfare Statutes: Arizona

Ariz. Rev. Stat. §§ 13-2910.07 to 13-2910.08

Current through legislation effective June 13, 2022 of the Second Regular Session of the Fifty-Fifth Legislature.

### § 13-2910.07. Cruel and inhumane confinement of a pig during pregnancy or of a calf raised for yeal

- A. Notwithstanding any other provision of title 3 or title 13, a person shall not tether or confine any pig during pregnancy or any calf raised for veal, on a farm, for all or the majority of any day, in a manner that prevents such animal from:
  - 1. Lying down and fully extending his or her limbs; or
  - 2. Turning around freely.
- B. This section shall not apply to:
  - 1. Pigs or calves during transportation.
  - 2. Pigs or calves in rodeo exhibitions, state or county fair exhibitions, or other similar exhibitions.
  - 3. The killing of pigs or calves according to the provisions of chapter 13, title 3 and other applicable law and regulations.
  - 4. Pigs or calves involved in lawful scientific or agricultural research.
  - 5. Pigs or calves while undergoing an examination, test, treatment or operation for veterinary purposes.
  - 6. A pig during the seven-day period prior to the pig's expected date of giving birth.
- C. A person who violates this section is guilty of a class 1 misdemeanor.
- D. The following definitions shall govern this section:
  - 1. "Calf" means a calf of the bovine species.
    - 2. "Calf raised for veal" means a calf raised with the intent of selling, marketing or distributing the meat, organs or any part of such calf as a food product described as "veal."

- 3. "Farm" means the land, buildings, support facilities, and other equipment that is wholly or partially used for the production of animals for food or fiber.
- 4. "Pig" means any animal of the porcine species.



5. "Turning around freely" means having the ability to turn around in a complete circle without any impediment, including a tether, or, in the case of an enclosure (including what is commonly described as a "gestation crate" for pigs and a "veal crate" for calves) without touching any side of the enclosure.

#### § 13-2910.08. The humane treatment of farm animals fund

#### Conditional enactment

The "humane treatment of farm animals fund" is hereby established to be administered by the attorney general under the conditions and for the purposes provided by this section. Upon receipt, the attorney general shall deposit in the fund any monies received for the state as a result of enforcement of the humane treatment of farm animals act and any monies received by the attorney general as a money donation to the fund from any public or private group, society, association or individual. The monies in the fund shall be used only for mandatory expenditures, if any, required by the humane treatment of farm animals act and administration of the fund. Monies in the fund are not subject to legislative appropriation. The fund is exempt from statutory provisions relating to lapsing of appropriations and shall not revert to the general fund.

#### STATE OF ARIZONA

Current through the Second Regular Session of the Fifty-Second Legislature (2016)

# § 13-2910. Cruelty to animals; interference with working or service animal; classification; definitions

- A. A person commits cruelty to animals if the person does any of the following:
  - 1. Intentionally, knowingly or recklessly subjects any animal under the person's custody or control to cruel neglect or abandonment.
  - 2. Intentionally, knowingly or recklessly fails to provide medical attention necessary to prevent protracted suffering to any animal under the person's custody or control.
  - 3. Intentionally, knowingly or recklessly inflicts unnecessary physical injury to any animal.
  - 4. Recklessly subjects any animal to cruel mistreatment.
  - 5. Intentionally, knowingly or recklessly kills any animal under the custody or control of another person without either legal privilege or consent of the owner.
  - 6. Recklessly interferes with, kills or harms a working or service animal without either legal privilege or consent of the owner.
  - 7. Intentionally, knowingly or recklessly leaves an animal unattended and confined in a motor vehicle and physical injury to or death of the animal is likely to result.
  - 8. Intentionally or knowingly subjects any animal under the person's custody or control to cruel neglect or abandonment that results in serious physical injury to the animal.
  - 9. Intentionally or knowingly subjects any animal to cruel mistreatment.
  - 10. Intentionally or knowingly interferes with, kills or harms a working or service animal without either legal privilege or consent of the owner.

- 11. Intentionally or knowingly allows any dog that is under the person's custody or control to interfere with, kill or cause physical injury to a service animal.
- 12. Recklessly allows any dog that is under the person's custody or control to interfere with, kill or cause physical injury to a service animal.
- 13. Intentionally or knowingly obtains or exerts unauthorized control over a service animal with the intent to deprive the service animal handler of the service animal.

#### B. It is a defense to subsection A of this section if:

- 1. Any person exposes poison to be taken by a dog that has killed or wounded livestock or poison to be taken by predatory animals on premises owned, leased or controlled by the person for the purpose of protecting the person or the person's livestock or poultry, the treated property is kept posted by the person who authorized or performed the treatment until the poison has been removed and the poison is removed by the person exposing the poison after the threat to the person or the person's livestock or poultry has ceased to exist. The posting required shall provide adequate warning to persons who enter the property by the point or points of normal entry. The warning notice that is posted shall be readable at a distance of fifty feet, shall contain a poison statement and symbol and shall state the word "danger" or "warning".
- 2. Any person uses poisons in and immediately around buildings owned, leased or controlled by the person for the purpose of controlling wild and domestic rodents as otherwise allowed by the laws of the state, excluding any fur-bearing animals as defined in § 17-101.

#### C. This section does not prohibit or restrict:

- 1. The taking of wildlife or other activities permitted by or pursuant to title 17.1
- 2. Activities permitted by or pursuant to title 3.2
- 3. Activities regulated by the Arizona game and fish department or the Arizona department of agriculture.
- D. A peace officer, animal control enforcement agent or animal control enforcement deputy may use reasonable force to open a vehicle to rescue an animal if the animal is left in the vehicle as prescribed in subsection A, paragraph 7 of this section.
- E. A person who is convicted of a violation of subsection A, paragraph 6 or 10 of this section is liable as follows:
  - 1. If the working or service animal was killed or disabled, to the owner or agency that owns the working or service animal and that employs the handler or

to the owner or handler for the replacement and training costs of the working or service animal and for any veterinary bills.

- 2. To the owner or agency that owns a working or service animal for the salary of the handler for the period of time that the handler's services are lost to the owner or agency.
- 3. To the owner for the owner's contractual losses with the agency.
- F. An incorporated city or town or a county may adopt an ordinance with misdemeanor provisions at least as stringent as the misdemeanor provisions of this section, except that any ordinance adopted shall not prohibit or restrict any activity involving a dog, whether the dog is restrained or not, if the activity is directly related to the business of shepherding or herding livestock and the activity is necessary for the safety of a human, the dog or livestock or is permitted by or pursuant to title 3.
- G. A person who violates subsection A, paragraph 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 or 12 of this section is guilty of a class 1 misdemeanor. A person who violates subsection A, paragraph 8, 9, 10, 11 or 13 of this section is guilty of a class 6 felony.
- H. For the purposes of this section:
  - 1. "Animal" means a mammal, bird, reptile or amphibian.
  - 2. "Cruel mistreatment" means to torture or otherwise inflict unnecessary serious physical injury on an animal or to kill an animal in a manner that causes protracted suffering to the animal.
  - 3. "Cruel neglect" means to fail to provide an animal with necessary food, water or shelter.
  - 4. "Handler" means a law enforcement officer or any other person who has successfully completed a course of training prescribed by the person's agency or the service animal owner and who used a specially trained animal under the direction of the person's agency or the service animal owner.
  - 5. "Service animal" means an animal that has completed a formal training program, that assists its owner in one or more daily living tasks that are associated with a productive lifestyle and that is trained to not pose a danger to the health and safety of the general public.
  - 6. "Working animal" means a horse or dog that is used by a law enforcement agency, that is specially trained for law enforcement work and that is under the control of a handler.

#### A. A person commits animal fighting by knowingly:

- 1. Owning, possessing, keeping or training any animal if the person knows or has reason to know that the animal will engage in an exhibition of fighting with another animal.
- 2. For amusement or gain, causing any animal to fight with another animal, or causing any animals to injure each other.
- 3. Permitting any act in violation of paragraph 1 or 2 to be done on any premises under the person's charge or control.

#### B. This section does not:

- 1. Prohibit or restrict activities permitted by or pursuant to title 3.1
- 2. Apply to animals that are trained to protect livestock from predation and that engage in actions to protect livestock.
- C. Animal fighting is a class 5 felony.

#### § 13-2910.02. Presence at animal fight; classification

Any person who is knowingly present at any place or building where preparations are being made for an exhibition of the fighting of animals, or who is present at such exhibition, is guilty of a class 6 felony.

#### § 13-2910.03. Cockfighting; classification

- A. A person commits cockfighting by knowingly:
  - 1. Owning, possessing, keeping or training any cock with the intent that such cock engage in an exhibition of fighting with another cock.
  - 2. For amusement or gain, causing any cock to fight with another cock or causing any cocks to injure each other.
  - 3. Permitting any act in violation of paragraph 1 or 2 to be done on any premises under his charge or control.
- B. Cockfighting is a class 5 felony.
- C. For purposes of this section and § 13-2910.04, cock means any male chicken, including game fowl except wildlife as defined in Arizona Revised Statutes § 17-101.

#### § 13-2910.04. Presence at cockfight; classification

Any person who is knowingly present at any place or building where preparations are being made for an exhibition of the fighting of cocks, or is present at such exhibition, is guilty of a class 1 misdemeanor.

#### § 13-2910.05. Exempt activities

Activity involving the possession, training, exhibition or use of an animal in the otherwise lawful pursuits of hunting, ranching, farming, rodeos, shows and security services shall be exempt from the provisions of §§ 13-2910.01, 13-2910.02, 13-2910.03 and 13-2910.04.

#### § 13-2910.06. Defense to cruelty to animals and bird fighting

It is a defense to §§ 13-2910, 13-2910.01, 13-2910.02, 13-2910.03 and 13-2910.04 that the activity charged involves the possession, training, exhibition or use of a bird or animal in the otherwise lawful sports of falconry, animal hunting, rodeos, ranching or the training or use of hunting dogs.

## § 13-2910.07. Cruel and inhumane confinement of a pig during pregnancy or of a calf raised for veal

A. Notwithstanding any other provision of title 31 or title 13,2 a person shall not tether or confine any pig during pregnancy or any calf raised for veal, on a farm, for all or the majority of any day, in a manner that prevents such animal from:

- 1. Lying down and fully extending his or her limbs; or
- 2. Turning around freely.
- B. This section shall not apply to:
- 1. Pigs or calves during transportation.
- 2. Pigs or calves in rodeo exhibitions, state or county fair exhibitions, or other similar exhibitions.
- 3. The killing of pigs or calves according to the provisions of chapter 13, title 33 and other applicable law and regulations.
- 4. Pigs or calves involved in lawful scientific or agricultural research.
- 5. Pigs or calves while undergoing an examination, test, treatment or operation for veterinary purposes.
- 6. A pig during the seven day period prior to the pig's expected date of giving birth.

- C. A person who violates this section is guilty of a class 1 misdemeanor.
- D. The following definitions shall govern this section:
  - 1. "Calf" means a calf of the bovine species.
  - 2. "Calf raised for veal" means a calf raised with the intent of selling, marketing or distributing the meat, organs or any part of such calf as a food product described as "veal."

#### § 13-2910.08. The humane treatment of farm animals fund


<Conditional enactment>

#### § 13-2910.09. Equine tripping; classification; definitions

- A. A person who knowingly or intentionally trips an equine for entertainment or sport is guilty of a class 1 misdemeanor.
- B. A person who is convicted of a first violation of this section:
  - 1. Shall be sentenced to serve not less than forty-eight consecutive hours in jail and is not eligible for probation or suspension of execution of sentence unless the entire sentence is served.
- 2. Shall pay a fine of not less than one thousand dollars.

- C. A person who is convicted of a second violation of this section:
  - 1. Shall be sentenced to serve not less than thirty consecutive days in jail and is not eligible for probation or suspension of execution of sentence unless the entire sentence is served.
  - 2. Shall pay a fine of not less than two thousand dollars.
- D. A person who is convicted of a third or subsequent violation of this section:
  - 1. Shall be sentenced to serve not less than ninety consecutive days in jail and is not eligible for probation or suspension of execution of sentence unless the entire sentence is served.
  - 2. Shall pay a fine of not less than two thousand dollars.
- E. This section does not apply to any jumping or steeplechase events, racing, training, branding, show events, calf or steer roping events, bulldogging or steer wrestling events or any other traditional western rodeo events, including barrel racing, bareback or saddled bronc riding or other similar activities or events.
- F. For the purposes of this section:
  - 1. "Equine" means a horse, pony, mule, donkey or hinny.
  - 2. "Trips" means knowingly or intentionally causing an equine to lose its balance or fall by use of a wire, pole, stick or rope or any other object or by any other means.
